

Policy for use of the facilities of Central Church of the Nazarene for Weddings and Receptions

1. All wedding/reception activities must be over by 10 p.m. Weddings and/or receptions will not be scheduled on Sundays.
2. The use of rice, birdseed, or confetti is prohibited.
3. The use of alcoholic beverages, illegal and/or dangerous drugs, and tobacco is prohibited on the church property. A wedding rehearsal or wedding will not be conducted when any member of the party is under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.
4. The Senior Pastor must approve all music. Dancing is not permitted.
5. All fees must be paid at least fifteen (15) days prior to the wedding.
6. Weddings held at this church will be performed by a minister on the staff of Central Church of the Nazarene and be for members only. Other clergy are welcome to assist in the ceremony as the couple and staff minister agree. Denominational courtesy may be extended to members of other Nazarene churches.
7. If, after plans have been developed for the wedding, any situation comes to light that makes a marriage unlawful by the doctrines and practices of the Church of the Nazarene, we reserve the right to cancel commitments made to the persons seeking to be married.
8. Applicants will be solely responsible for loss or damage to property, death or injury of any person or persons arising out of or connected with the use of the facilities by the applicant.
9. Applicant accepts the facilities, including premises and equipment, in the condition in which they exist prior to rental, and expressly agrees to protect, indemnify and hold harmless the Central Church of the Nazarene, its pastors, officers, trustees, employees, representatives and members from any and all liability, claim, damage, loss, expense or causes of action or causes of suit, arising out of, or resulting from use of the Activity Center by the applicant.
10. No decorations or the application of materials to the walls, floors, or equipment of the facilities will be allowed without prior approval.
11. Applicants are responsible to see that all flowers, food, decorations and personal belongings are removed from the facilities immediately following the wedding/reception.

12. All food and drink will be served and eaten in the multipurpose room (gym). No food or drink is allowed in any other room of the church facility.
13. No children under the age of 15 may be in the kitchen at any time.
14. The wedding party and guests will use only those portions of the building reserved for the occasion, *i.e.* sanctuary, dressing rooms, gym, etc. They will not wander into other parts of the building.
15. Facility will be opened and closed by staff or a designated church member only.
